To Obtain an IFR Clearance:

- Ground (VHF)- 122.20 MHz (San Angelo Radio)(on the airport)
- Ground (telephone)- 1-800-433-8101 (San Angelo Flight Data desk)
- Ground (telephone)- 1-800-992-7433 (San Angelo FSS)
- Airborne- 134.60 MHz (Houston Center, N & E)
- Airborne- 127.80 MHz (Houston Center, S)
- Airborne- 134.95 MHz (Houston Center, NW)

General Notes:

1. Request clearance as soon as your radios are on, even prior to taxi.
2. Aircraft outbound from (or inbound to) Carrizo Springs, Pearsall, or private ranch airports in a thirty mile radius will delay you from receiving clearance.
3. Likewise, aircraft cleared to take-off from Cotulla but not yet airborne will block other traffic in the same area.
4. Clearances are issued with a Void Time.
5. Communications with Houston Center cannot be obtained until about 3,500 MSL.
6. Most departure clearances initially direct aircraft to the COT VOR with a climb to 4,000' MSL. I suggest you report airborne as soon as possible to "request higher".
7. On rare occasions, aircraft have been cleared only to the COT VOR, with an Expect Further Clearance time. Be alert.

The Cotulla airport (KCOT) recently opened with a new longer and wider runway (5,005' x 75'), as well as numerous other improvements including a larger ramp.

- Four motels in town
- Easy vehicle access to San Antonio or Laredo via Interstate 35
- Rent cars on site
- Catering
- Single-point and over-the-wing refueling
- Reasonable fuel prices
- Aircraft Ground Power Unit (GPU)
- High-Pressure Aviators Breathing Oxygen
- A&P-IA Mechanic on staff

The weather at Cotulla is often “above minimums” when nearby airports are closed.
